She has done countless hours in projects already with our club and will be an excellent member of the YCPO committee.

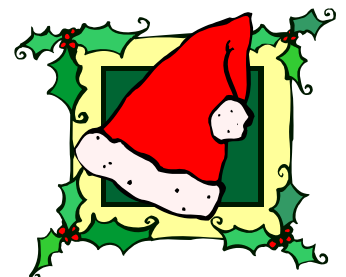
