We are pleased to confirm that K Royal Bodden has agreed to take on the rôle of President Elect 2011/2 vacated by K Jan-Michael Maw who can no longer commit since there is a good chance that he will have left the Cayman Islands.

K Royal is currently the President of the Cayman Contractors Association, and is a Director of Robson Construction Ltd. His family ancestry includes Captain Royal Brazley Bodden, one of Cayman's finest shipbuilders and the person who built most of the town halls in the districts of Grand Cayman and also the George Town post office and library.

K Royal will bring the talent of a constructor to the job of President in 2011/2. He is strongly ethical and was on the committee for the Governor's Award for Design and Construction Excellence.

## Why We Should Be Supporting ELIMINATE...



Hey, buddy, got a spare \$110 million? If so, Kiwanis International and UNICEF need you.

Older members will remember that the Kiwanis organisation teamed with UNICEF to ensure that iodine was added to common salt during the manufacturing process in order to eliminate serious birth defects in babies. By simply ensuring that women ate salt treated with iodine the disease was eliminated. That project tackled Iodine Deficiency Disorder.

Now, Kiwanis and UNICEF want to target Maternal and Neonatal Tetanus (MNT), a disease which steals the lives of nearly 60,000 innocent babies and a significant number of women each year. The effects of the disease are excruciating — tiny newborns suffer repeated, painful convulsions and extreme sensitivity to light and touch.

To eliminate MNT from the Earth by 2015, 129 million mothers and their fu-

ture babies must be immunized. This requires vaccines, syringes, safe storage, transportation, thousands of skilled staff and more. It will take \$110 million — and the dedicated work of UNICEF and every member of the Kiwanis family. The project will reach the poorest, most neglected mothers and babies with additional lifesaving health care.

The end of this disease means the beginning of better health for so many families.

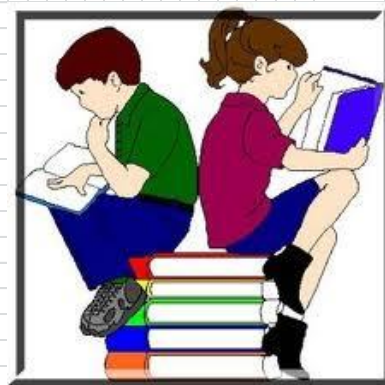
