KCGC/Rotary Central meet

President Ruud and Past President Paul, founder of the BAKB project, met last Wednesday evening with Rotary Central President Wil Pineau and members of his Board of Directors.

Kiwanis attended as guests for the first half-hour of the monthly Rotary Central board meeting - a rare and welcome event. P. Wil welcomed Kiwanis to the meeting and stated that a goal of his year was to reinvigorate service club interaction by conducting an ongoing joint project with another club outside of Rotary. The Kiwanis Club of Grand Cayman was chosen since, in their annual community survey, Rotary Central had requests from a number of schools for financial assistance against student hunger, and this tied in nicely with the Kiwanis Buy A Kid Breakfast campaign and Rotary Central's Meals on Wheels.

The key issue was whether both sides could simply view the schools' needs in a way that was detached from timing - breakfast, snacks, lunch or whatever. President Wiekert confirmed that the Kiwanis Club Of Grand Cayman trusted the Principals of the schools involved to make the best use of the

funds donated, whether that be for morning or midday meals since needs varied.

This was further confirmed at Fosters last Saturday by one of the teachers responsible for the application of funds donated from BAKB. She said that the need was increasing in terms of the number of children, although not all needed help every day or week.

Principal Carla MacVicar of The Lighthouse School has now also requested assistance for some of the handicapped children at that school. A couple of the children arrive at school every day with nothing more than two pieces of white bread and a piece of balogna (baloney) meat in between. She states that the parents try but just cannot afford anything more.

Presidents Wil and Wiekert have agreed to set up an interclub committee to work out how Rotary Central can support BAKB financially in an expanded role across the schools and work with Kiwanis to ensure that no child suffers through hunger. KNews will report further on the work of the interclub committee.

Our Buy A Kid Breakfast collection at Fosters - Airport last Saturday netted CI\$1,533. Noticeable was a reduction in the traffic through the supermarket which was unusual since it was not a bank holiday weekend.

PP Ruud, fund-raising committee chair, offered a big thank you to K Alexandra, PP Paul, K Kadi, PLG Ernest, P Wiekert, PP Mario, Belinda (Prospective member), K Millicent, K Twyla and especially to prospective member Belinda for a great result under the circum-

stances. He also congratulated Cayman Prep High School Key Club who turned out to help cope with the number of doors at Fosters Airport.

The amount collected for the Buy A Kid Breakfast project is now CI\$102,632 (US\$ 123,160). We are no longer banking small change but rather placing it into a 5-gallon water cooler bottle where it will become part of a future “Guess the value” fund-raiser effectively doubling or trebling, or raising even more, its bankable value.
