## Kiwanibike Trophy presented

2010 Kiwanibike Chair Monique Bush and President Wiekert presented the new Kiwanibike trophy to representatives of the Phoenix Group team at lunch on Wednesday 16th February.

On hand to receive the trophy were riders Michelle Miller and Mary Anne Kosa. Also present was Neil Rooney who gave Kiwanis members a talk on the work of the Phoenix group of companies and especially on their Design/Build philosophy for design, construction and sustainability. He concluded his talk with a list of some of the ways in which Phoenix contributes either time, talent or treasure to various service initiatives in Cayman.

Phoenix Group comprises five small companies with a total staff of about 35 persons. During Kiwanibike, the team turned in the equivalent of over C\$13.30 per company employee, just about double the results from any other participating company team.

The new Kiwanibike Trophy depicts a cyclist on a mountain bike, to emphasise that the event is not a race. The plinth, specially created by Mr, Ransdale Rankine, an instructor at the



Northward Prison carpentry workshop, is Cayman mahogany, and replaced entirely a short plastic plinth on which the trophy originally stood. The new plinth, besides being beautiful, has space for many years of Kiwanibike winners, of which the Phoenix Group is the first. The trophy was supplied by Marvin Hurlston of GT Crafts in George Town.
